

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SEALY, TEXAS, BY ADDING TO ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 80 THEREOF A SUBPARAGRAPH (8) TO SECTION 80-12; PROVIDING AN EXEMPTION FROM REGULATION TO ALLOW SPONSORSHIP SIGNS TO BE INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY OF SEALY PARKS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITY POLICY AND PROCEDURE GUIDELINES AND LOCATED AT ALL CITY PARKS; PROVIDING A PENALTY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500 FOR VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION HEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEALY, TEXAS:

Section 1. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Sealy, Texas, is hereby amended by adding to Article II of Chapter 80 thereof a subparagraph (8) to Section 80-12 to read as follows:

“Sec. 80-12. Exemptions for certain types of signs.

...

(8) Sponsorship signs installed in accordance with the City of Sealy Parks and Recreational Facility Policy and Procedure Guidelines and located at all City Parks.


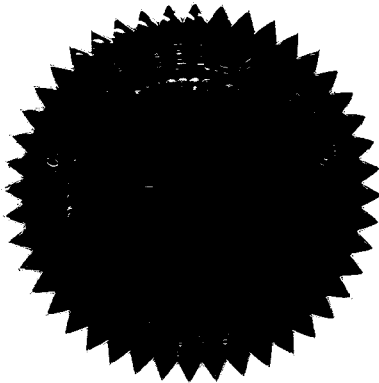
Section 2. Any person who shall intentionally, knowingly, recklessly, or with criminal negligence, violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$500. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. In the event any clause phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be

adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Sealy, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more .


